You are invited to attend the Long and Ringo Lakes Excessive Nutrients Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) Stakeholders meeting.

The Hawk Creek Watershed Project (HCWP) is holding a stakeholders meeting addressing the assessment report for an Excessive Nutrient TMDL for Long Lake/Ringo Lake.

In this meeting comments about the draft assessment report will be discussed by citizens that are interested in taking part as a stakeholder.

A TMDL is a scientific study that calculates the maximum amount of a pollutant that a water body can receive and still meet water quality standards for that pollutant. It is also a process that identifies all potential sources of the pollutant causing the impairment and identifies methods for achieving reductions.

A draft TMDL report is scheduled to be completed by 2011.
